SWHR is leading the effort to reshape health care policies and practices to more effectively meet the unique needs of women, their families, and their communities.

SWHR raises awareness around critical health issues, such as **cardiovascular disease**, **autoimmune conditions**, **gynecologic health**, and natural life stages like **menopause**, ensuring women's distinct health needs are acknowledged and prioritized in research.
